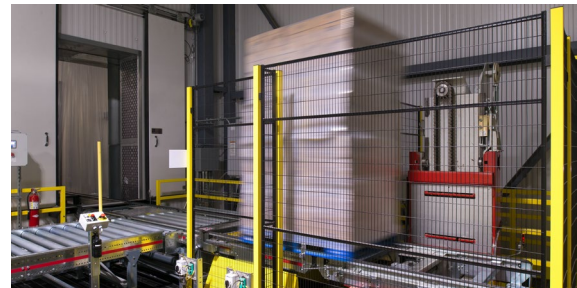
Facts and Figures
